## **Dear County Directors of Social Services**

- Attention: Food and Nutrition Services Administrators, Managers and Supervisors, Work First Program Administrators, Managers and Supervisors
- Subject: Income of Temporary Census Employment
- **Priority:** For Information Only

This is a reminder that the Food and Nutrition Services (FNS) and Work First (WF) programs will disregard income from temporary census workers when determining eligibility for FNS and WF applicants/recipients. Income must be disregarded from October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020. Only the income directly received from the Census Bureau can be excluded. Income cannot be excluded for applicants/recipients employed by an outside contractor.

Excluding the earned income of temporary census employees will help FNS and Work First applicants/recipients earn extra income while assisting our state in ensuring an accurate census. For further guidance refer to <u>Administrative Letter EFS FNS AL-2-2019</u> and the Integrated Eligibility Manual <u>4040 Non-countable Income</u>.
