<u>DSS Administrative Letter AL-14-2020</u> announced that North Carolina was approved to pilot a plan to authorize retail food stores to accept SNAP benefits via online transactions with an Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) card. This allows households across North Carolina to purchase eligible food items online using SNAP benefits.

Currently, Amazon, Walmart, Carlie C's retailers are approved by USDA to allow online purchasing. We are happy to announce that Aldi has received approval and will be going live with online purchasing effective December 15, 2020. Aldi has over 50 locations throughout North Carolina.
