Adding Energy applications to the online ePASS portal is another convenient way that potential applicants can apply for Energy programs. Applicants can also call their County Department of Social Services to apply by phone, or print a paper application from www.epass.nc.gov to mail, fax, or drop off at the County Department of Social Services.
