SUBJECT: Suggestions for the Next TANF State Plan

Dear County Director and Work First Stakeholders:

It is now time to develop a new State TANF Plan for North Carolina. An important part of this planning process is the input from stakeholders from across the State. At this time, the Division is receiving and reviewing the County Work First Plans from each of the 100 county departments of social services. Nine counties have designated their desire to be Electing counties. They are: Beaufort, Caldwell, Catawba, Cumberland, Iredell, Lenoir, Lincoln, Macon and Wilson. Once reviewed and approved for recommendation to the General Assembly, these Electing county plans will be summarized in the State TANF Plan.

In the meantime, we will be reviewing the current <u>State TANF Plan</u> and considering any changes deemed necessary and advisable. We will then begin drafting the section of the State TANF Plan for Standard counties. In this process, we are requesting your input for any changes that you would suggest for us to consider. It is through the partnership with the county departments of social services and stakeholders from other state and community agencies that is crucial in shaping the delivery of services for this State TANF Plan and any programmatic changes that will assist the State in serving Work First families and meeting the mandatory Work Participation Rates, while maintaining a family-centered approach in our service delivery.
