RE: Disaster Food Stamp Training

Dear County Director of Social Services:

In the event of a hurricane, tornado or other event that affects our citizens, operation of a successful Disaster Food Stamp Program is dependent upon adequate planning and preparation at both the state and local levels. Predictions for the 2005 Hurricane season indicate a slightly above average year, with eleven named storms in the forecast.

Disaster Food Stamp planning meetings will be conducted in early May to help you prepare for a disaster situation. Topics for the meeting will include a review of policy and procedures, automation and logistical planning considerations. We also will reflect on the most recent disasters and hear from counties that participated in the delivery of disaster benefits as a result of these disasters. We would like for counties that administered the Disaster Food Stamp Program in recent disasters to share some best practices which your counties used during the disaster. You may wish to review and bring to the meeting your Disaster Food Stamp Manual published in April 2002. The Disaster Food Stamp Manual is also located online at www.dhhs.state.nc.us/olm/manuals in the Economic Services subdirectory.
