Are you having trouble paying the child support you owe along with the rest of your bills?

If you are having a hard time making your child support payment and meeting the rest of your bills, you can apply for **Food Stamps**. Here is some information you should know:

- You can apply for Food Stamps even if you have been denied before because you were over income.
- Because of a change in the rules, your child support payments are now subtracted from your income before deciding if you are eligible for Food Stamp benefits.
- You can apply for Food Stamps at your local Department of Social Services. The address and telephone number are in your local telephone book.
