Re: New Food Stamp Telephone PIN Selection Procedures for Individuals Without a Social Security Number

Dear County Director Letter FAEP-12-2005, dated June 22, 2005, provided instructions for the Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) Card PIN selection process for individuals without a Social Security Number (SSN). The instructions in FAEP-12-2005 were an interim solution pending implementation of an alternative unique identifier consisting of the cardholder s date of birth.

The new PIN procedure for new or replacement EBT cards for individuals without a SSN will be effective August 25, 2005. Clients without a SSN will no longer need to come to the agency to get their EBT card PINned. Clients without SSN s will follow the same telephone PIN procedures as all other clients but will be prompted to enter date of birth by the Automated Response Unit (ARU) instead of the SSN. Caseworkers should advise clients without a SSN of the new procedure.

Please note that the interim solution of entering all zeroes for the SSN will be disabled effective August 25, 2005. Letter FAEP-12-2005 is also obsolete effective August 25, 2005. The new procedure will be added to the Food Stamp Certification Manual as soon as possible. If you have any questions, please contact your Food Assistance and Energy Programs Representative.
