NOTIFICATION OF LOW INCOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIEAP)

The Division of Social Services will issue a one-time energy check in February to all households who apply and meet the requirements of the Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP). This check is to help with your heating costs.

Most households that receive Food and Nutrition Services benefits for October may be eligible for an energy check. If you do not receive an approval notice from the County Department of Social Services in October, you must apply at the COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES if you want to receive this benefit.



The application period for the LIEAP program is November 5 through November 17. If you are elderly or disabled, you may:

- > Send someone to apply for you; or
- Call the county department of social services and ask to apply.
