## Re: Work First Performance Goals SFY 2004

## Dear County Director of Social Services

## Attention: Work First Supervisors Income Maintenance/Family Support Supervisors Work First Case Managers

The Division of Social Services, with assistance and support from the Employment Programs Committee, has established Work First goals for State Fiscal Year 2003-2004. These goals are considered tentative until the N.C. General Assembly approves the 2003-2005 Work First Plan. A copy of the performance goals, with an explanation of the measures, is attached for your information.

Currently, federal law sets two of the Work First goals. The All-Parent Participation Rate is set at 50 percent, and the Two-Parent Participation Rate at 90 percent. It is anticipated that federal reauthorization of the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) Block Grant, will eliminate the Two-Parent Participation Rate as a program measure. Consequently, this goal, as well as any other goals impacted by reauthorization, will be reviewed and modified as necessary to reflect changes mandated by Congress.

As you will notice, two of the SFY 2003 goals (Child Support and Caseload Reduction) have been eliminated as SFY 2004 Work First Program measures. The Child Support Enforcement Section will measure child support performance for SFY 2004. It is believed that caseload reduction performance will be achieved through other Work First goals.
