## RE: Application Time Standards Chart For 2006

Dear County Director of Social Services:

## Attention: Work First Supervisors

Attached is a copy of the Application Time Standards Chart for 2006. The chart includes the calculated 13<sup>th</sup>, 45<sup>th</sup>, 60<sup>th</sup>, and 90<sup>th</sup> calendar day for each day of the year in 2006. It also includes the 6<sup>th</sup> month date for each day. Caseworkers who work with Work First and Medicaid applications may utilize this chart to determine the necessary application time standards rather than calculating each date manually.

This chart does not consider weekends and holidays in the 45<sup>th</sup>, 60<sup>th</sup>, and 90<sup>th</sup> day calculations. To determine the adjusted due date of an application, compare the due date listed on the chart to the calendar and your county holiday schedule. If the calculated due date falls on a non-workday, the adjusted due date for the Work First application is the last workday prior to the 45<sup>th</sup> calendar day. The Adjusted Application Management Report in NCXPTR calculates and displays the adjusted due date.
