



Substance Affected Infant Policy – Technical Assistance

- "Hot Topic" for CPRs through December
- NC DSS follow up with Director regarding concerning data trends
- Program Monitoring tool will begin to reflect policy requirements in January 2018

Substance Affected Infant Policy - Intake

- Prenatal Substance Use Abuse or Neglect
- Notification Screen-In
- Intake policy considers circumstances of exposure and effect to infant

Potential Consequences

- Women may avoid treatment for their substance use disorder
- Pregnant women may refuse prenatal care or choose to give birth outside of medical setting
- Abrupt discontinuation of opioids during pregnancy could result in harm to fetus
