Designate at least one staff representative to participate in approximately six virtual trainings/events

#### Project Requirements:

(NC self-nominated / accepted into TANF Academy)

- Work closely with the Office of Family Assistance / Technical Assistance Coaches
  - Develop a statement of goals
  - Assess service strengths and gaps
  - Develop action plans and track progress over the 18 month course of the Academy
  - Participate in regular (quarterly) communications with the Office of Family Assistance on post-project outcomes
