The Centers for Medicaid and Medicare Services (CMS) published the final rule on Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) provided through Medicaid's 1915 (c) HCBS waiver program. The intent is to enhance the quality of HCBS, to provide additional protections to waiver participants and ensure full access to the benefits of community living.
