Subject: State-Funded Peer Support Services (PSS) service definition

This bulletin informs LME-MCOs that effective August 1, 2019 the State-funded Peer Support Services (PSS) service definition will go live and supersede any existing alternative PSS service definitions. The following Y-codes will end on July 31, 2019:

PSS are an evidenced-based mental health and substance use disorder model of care that provides community-based recovery services directly to an adult diagnosed with a mental health or substance use disorder. PSS provides structured, scheduled services that promote recovery, self-determination, self-advocacy, engagement in self-care and wellness and enhancement of community living skills of individuals.

PSS services are directly provided by Certified Peer Support Specialists (CPSS) who have self-identified as a person(s) in recovery from a mental health or substance use disorder. PSS can be provided in combination with other approved mental health or substance use services or as an NC DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

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independent service, and can be delivered in an individual's home, community, office, hospital emergency department or hospital in-patient setting. It can be provided in group or individual settings.

Agencies providing PSS will be required to use the following billing codes:
