Tailored CM Provider Certification Updates

- The Department continues to work with NC AHEC and NCQA to help providers become certified, in Tailored Care Management.
- 20 providers have been certified: 18 CMAs, 2 AMH+s.
- 30 Site visits completed.
- All Round 1 Site Reviews are anticipated to be complete by May 31, 2022.
- All Round 2 Site Reviews are anticipated to be completed by June 30, 2022.
- <u>Certification</u> = passed desk & site review.
- Providers are eligible for capacity building payments once they pass the full certification process.
- *Providers then need to pass readiness & contract with TPs prior to launch*

Capacity Building Distributions


The Department has secured approximately \$90 million for the capacity building program for 2022 through 2023. To date, approved Distribution Plans reflect **\$35,400,000** in funding; 40% of total funding has been distributed, with the remainder to be distributed throughout 2022 and 2023.

Capacity Building Distributions	
Total Distribution Allocation Approved	\$88,500,000
Total Allocated for TPs to keep	\$8,850,000
Total Approved for Providers	\$79,650,000
Total Funds Distributed as of 5/5/22	\$35,400,000

Tailored CM Provider Updates

- 1. <u>Certification</u> (slide 3)
- 2. Capacity Building (slide 4)
- 3. <u>Readiness</u>: TPs/DHHS/NCQA working on a streamlined process including: –Standard tool, scoring protocol, data repository;
 - -Focusing on issues from site visits (rather than re-reviewing everything again)
 - -Consolidated review for providers who cross multiple TPs
- 4. <u>Contracting</u>: DHHS has shared STCs (standard terms & conditions) for TCM providers
- 5. Choice Period (8/15-10/15): Offered by TP; will be contracted providers
- 6. <u>Auto Assignment</u>: 10/15; providers need to finish readiness review & contracting by 9/30ish
 - Auto-assignment looks at current relationships (BH/SUD, AMH+); providers also need to set panel limits with TPs during contracting. Providers can continue to add more or have open panels
- 7. <u>Workforce Concerns</u>: listening sessions with TPs, TCM TAG, and providers on workforce concerns; open to ways TCM changes can help workforce issues
