**Subject: Fiscal Reporting Procedures for the Child Support Enforcement (CSE) Incentive Recovery**

Effective with May 2009 services reimbursed June 2009, all counties will need to use the following codes to claim reimbursement for the **CSE Incentive Recovery** funds on the DSS-1571. These codes will be used to retroactively claim applicable CSE expenditures from October payment 2008.

**Part IC: (Salary and Fringe Benefits)**

Application Code **202**, Function Code **79**, Column **14**, **CSE Incentive Recovery** 66% Fed / 34% County

**Part II: (Administrative Expenditures and/or Purchased Services)** The following codes will be tracked in application code 202, the reimbursement will be 66% Federal funds.

**Part IV: There are no Part IV coding requirements.**

The CFDA number for this fund is 93.563. The related cost for application code 202 will be tracked on the XS411 report under the heading "CSE Incentive Rec".
