Subject: Fiscal Reporting Procedures regarding Permanency Planning County

Effective beginning April 2013 services reimbursed May 2013, all counties, including Native American Counties, will temporarily (through June 2013 reimbursement) be able to use the following codes to make reclassifications with the Permanency Planning County code on the DSS-1571. These expenditures are eligible to be claimed using the following coding retroactively from June 2012 service month.

Part IA (Service and Fringe Benefits): The Part I coding will be tracked as application code 465 Permanency Planning County. This application code is 100% County share on all financial reporting and, the Part I coding for Permanency Planning County is Function Code 25, Column 18.

Part II: (Administrative Expenditures and/or Purchased Services) The following codes will be used on Part II to track Permanency Planning County application code 465.
