Subject: Fiscal Reporting Procedures regarding Employment and Training SNAP 100% reimbursement

Effective beginning October 2015 services reimbursed November 2015, Mecklenburg and Orange Counties will need to use the following code to claim reimbursement for 100% Employment and Training SNAP on their DSS-1571 report.

Part IA: (Service-Salary and Fringe Benefits)

Application Code 466, Function Code 11, Column 09, 100% Employment and Training SNAP (100% E&T SNAP) 100% Federal funds

Part II: (Administrative Expenditures and/or Purchased Services) There is <u>no</u> Part II coding requirements.

Part IV: (Purchased Services requiring client ID) There is <u>no</u> Part IV coding requirements.

The CFDA number for this fund is 10.561. 100% Employment and Training SNAP is not an allocated capped fund thus cost for application code 466 will not be tracked on the DSS XS411c report.

In terms of overhead for the application code in your Maximus software, this program will **not** draw overhead from Income Maintenance Supervision & Clerical, IV-D Supervision & Clerical or Joint IM & IV-D Workers.
