Hospital Rules for Visitors

- Anyone with symptoms such as fever, cough, congestion, vomiting, or diarrhea are asked to refrain from visiting.
- Personal items such as purses, cell phones, and pocket knives are not allowed in patient areas and should be secured in vehicle.
- All visitors must report to Guest Services in the hospital lobby for registration.
- All visitors will be electronically scanned and their possessions will be searched prior to entering the patient areas.
- Unsafe articles such as metal and glass are not permitted in patient areas.
- No photos, video recording, or audio recording without prior authorization.
- Alcohol, weapons, and drugs are prohibited. Violators are subject to prosecution.
- Food during visitation is limited to one individual prepackaged snack and one (20 ounce or smaller) prepackaged drink (no canned or glass containers). These items must be consumed during the visit.
- Visitors may bring personal hygiene items when visiting. The items will be received by Guest Services who will contact unit staff to obtain the items for inventory. (no medications or supplements, no aerosol cans, no items containing alcohol or ethanol)
- Money left for patients must be given to a staff member, a receipt will be given and the money will be secured.
- Persons who have been convicted of a sex offense and ordered to register as a sex offender are prohibited from visiting our adolescent population.
- Broughton Hospital is a tobacco-free campus. Tobacco products, smokeless tobacco products, vape products, lighters, matches, and other flame producing devices are prohibited.
