These tables show the number of children who were enrolled in programs or services during the 2013-2014 School Year and who turned 4 between 9/1/2012 and 8/31/2013. Turning four during this time frame is the eligibility age range for participation in NC Pre-K, North Carolina's state-funded pre-kindergarten program. A child who was enrolled in NC Pre-K at any time during the 2013-2014 School Year is included in this report.

- **Table 1** shows children in NC Pre-K who were either only in NC Pre-K or who were in NC Pre-K as well as another program during the 2013-2014 School Year. It should be noted that children may have received more than one service simultaneously or consecutively. This table highlights some, but not all, of the combinations of services that children in NC Pre-K may be receiving. Therefore, the percentages in this table will not add up to 100%.
- **Table 2** shows children who were in the eligible age range for NC Pre-K but were not served by that program. They were, however, receiving other services. Even though these children were not served by NC Pre-K, some of them may have met other, non-aged based Pre-K eligibility criteria, such as income eligibility or exceptional children criteria. This table highlights some, but not all, of the combinations of services that children may be receiving. Therefore, the percentages will not add up to 100%.

Notes

1. Each agency and program participating in NC ECIDS maintains its own data, and each one has protocols for data entry and data quality. NC ECIDS does not conduct any additional data quality measures. All programs ensure the highest quality data to the extent possible.
2. When there is a count of children fewer than 10 in any cell, that number will not be shown. Those cells will display as VTSTS (Values Too Small To Show). When there are no children that meet the specific criteria within a cell (N=0), the cell will display as 0.0%.
3. All numbers may not add up to 100% due to rounding. It is also possible that some rows and/or columns may not be based on a total of 100%, so the user should read each table carefully.
