WHO WILL GET CHILD CARE P-EBT BENEFITS?		WHEN WILL P-EBT BENEFITS BE ISSUED?

 A child must meet <u>ALL</u> the following criteria to be eligible for benefits: 1. Child is 5 years old or younger (as of September 1, 2021) 2. Children over the age of 6 (as of September 1, 2021) 2. Children not part of an active FNS case (NC will check each child's FNS case status for each benefit month) 3. Children who receive Student P-EBT 	 and will be staggered over 3 days. Each issuance will contain multiple months of benefits (if eligible) according to this schedule: September – October 2021: Issued mid-May 2022. November – December 2021: Issued at the end of June 2022. January – February 2022: Issued at the end of July 2022. March – May 2022: Issued at the end of August 2022.

 IMPORTANT: Even if a child turns 6, they may continue to receive Child Care P-EBT if they 1) are still on an active FNS case and 2) are not a student and picked up in the Student P-EBT population. NOTE: Once approved, households who apply for FNS will receive P-EBT benefits retroactively back to the month of FNS application. If FNS benefits end, P-EBT benefits will also end. 		HOW MUCH WILL CHILDREN RECEIVE? Children will receive a statewide monthly benefit rate set by North Carolina according to federal guidelines. All children across the state will receive the <u>same</u> amount. This amount may change monthly.
