General Information

Visitors

Family members, relatives and friends may visit at any time. Children are allowed to visit when accompanied by an adult but they cannot be left unattended at any time.

Residents

Appliances

Residents are allowed to bring their own appliances such as radios and televisions. However, these items must be checked and labeled by the Plant Operations Department to ensure their proper identification and safe keeping.

Resident Personal Funds and Valuables

Provisions are made through the Center's Reimbursement Office for residents to open personal accounts. Individual accounts are maintained and money is dispensed as needed for the personal needs of the residents. Valuables may be kept in the facility vault. Families and visitors should leave any personal monies for residents at the Cashier's Office where a receipt is issued. Residents are encouraged to keep only small amounts of money in their possession.

Transportation

Longleaf Neuro-Medical Treatment Center maintains convalescent service for use in transporting residents to Wilson Medical Center and to other health care facilities. Transportation is also provided by the Wilson County Emergency Medical Services for emergencies.

Beauty and Barber Shop

A stylist provides basic hair care services for all residents on a monthly basis. Special requests are made through the Unit Social Worker.

Chapel

A small chapel is located in the Center for use by residents and their families. Devotional services are held weekly.
