

1915(i) Supported Employment Service Definition **Updates Provide New Opportunities to the I/DD community**

NCDHHS is pleased to announce the approval of the 1915(i) Supported Employment service definition for individuals with developmental disabilities. This will provide a gateway for Medicaid beneficiaries, who may not be involved in a Medicaid Waiver, to receive support in locating a job and guidance to help them in their work transition. 

Pre-Employment Transition Services for students with I/DD are

Employment Transition Services (ETS) to support students with disabilities move from high school to post-school employment goals. Pre-ETS are a set of activities defined by the federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) intended to expose students with disabilities at an early age to selfadvocacy, postsecondary training, and employments skills and options. Pre-ETS can include one or more of the following five activities: 1. Job Exploration Counseling

- 3. Instruction in Self-Advocacy 4. Counseling on Postsecondary Training Options
- 5. Work-Based Learning Experiences
