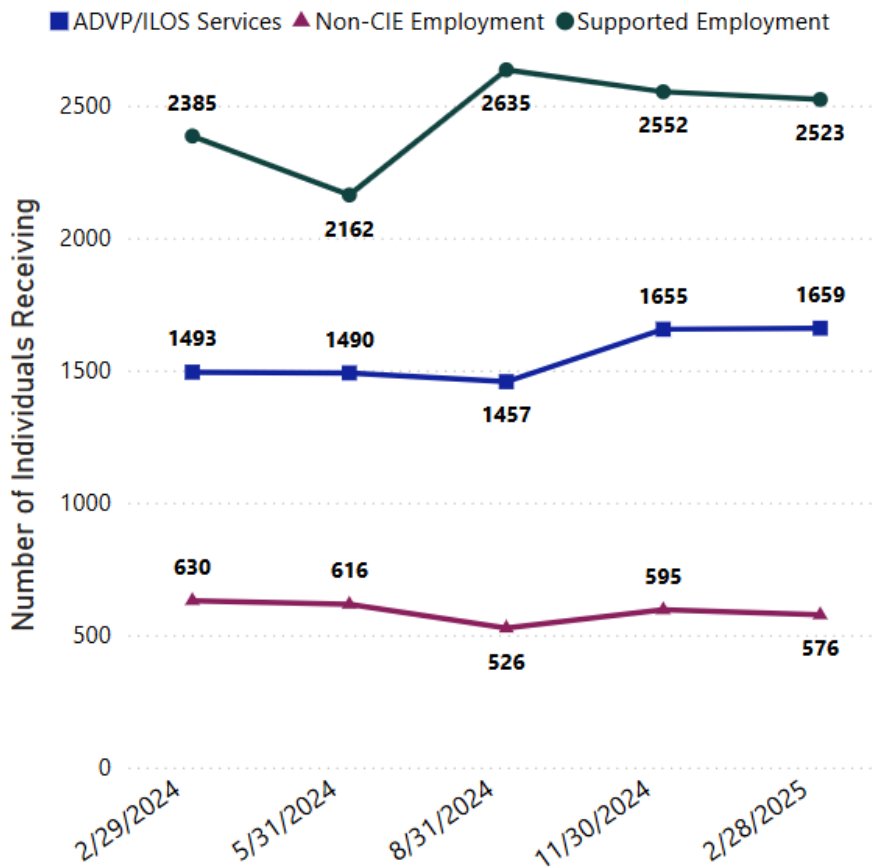


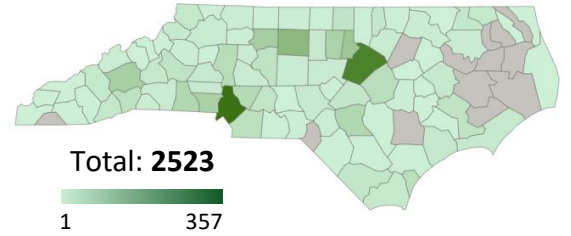
Inclusion Works Data Summary

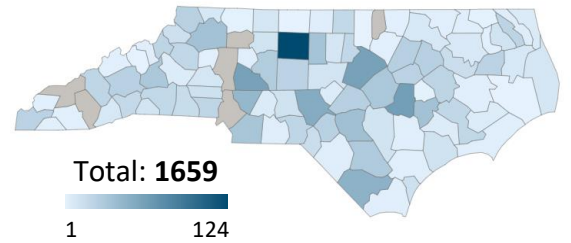
Key Inclusion Works Metrics



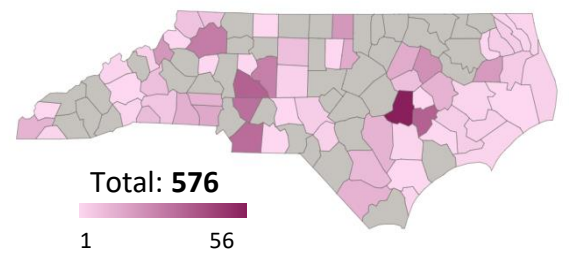
Individuals Receiving Supported Employment:

Supported Employment (SE)

Helps individuals achieve and maintain competitive integrated employment by offering job development, job placement, intensive training, and ongoing support in their jobs.

Adult Developmental Vocational Programs (ADVP)

Provide organized developmental activities for individuals with intellectual/ developmental disabilities to prepare the individual to live and work as independently as possible.

Non-CIE Jobs

Jobs that do not meet the criteria for CIE. These jobs are available to individuals with I/DD and are not in integrated settings and may pay less than minimum wage in NC.

Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) Services

The Division of Employment & Independence for People with Disabilities (EIPD) provides vocational rehabilitation (VR) services to help individuals overcome disability-related barriers and achieve goals for CIE and more.
