The following household size and incomes are used to determine CACFP eligibility categories of Free, Reduced, or Paid/Denied. Dollar amounts below show the upper end of the Free and Reduced income categories. Incomes below the dollar amount in the Free column are classified as Free. If the family income is over the dollar amount in the Free column, but less than the dollar amount in the Reduced column, the income eligibility is classified as Reduced. Incomes over the Reduced dollar amount in the Reduced column are classified as Paid/Denied.
