Subject: Update to Communication Bulletin #J247 – North Carolina Interventions (NCI)

This bulletin provides additional information to <u>LME-MCO Communication Bulletin # J247</u>, <u>North Carolina Interventions (NCI) to be Released to the Public Domain July 1, 2017</u>. The purpose of this communication bulletin is to inform you of important transition activities and to reiterate provider responsibilities during and after the phase-out of NCI.

The following provisions have been made for continuity to ensure all staff have valid certification in an approved curriculum during the transition period:

- NCI Instructor Trainer re-certifications scheduled to end on June 30, 2018 have been extended through December 31, 2018.
- Staff can receive certification or re-certification training in NCI through December 30, 2018.
- All NCI certifications, regardless of training date, will expire at 11:59 PM on December 31, 2018, at which time the NCI curriculum will officially phase-out and will no longer be an approved curriculum in North Carolina.

All other aspects of Communication Bulletin #J247 remain in effect. Please remember to submit applications for curriculum review in a searchable pdf format. In addition, by December 31, 2018, all providers shall have implemented and trained their staff in the new curriculum which will replace NCI.
