# P-EBT for Child Care

## Child and Adult Care Food Program

- P-EBT for Children Under Six was issued through the end of May.
- Summer P-EBT is now in effect
  - Each child is eligible for one-P-EBT benefit during the summer months
  - Amount of \$375 per child will be paid in one payment to families currently participating in Food and Nutrition Services (SNAP)
  - Payments are scheduled to go out later this month

# Emergency Cost Reimbursement Benefits Timeline



May 30, 2021

Institutions will receive an official notice from the State agency

- Anticipated reimbursement amount
- Acceptable use of funds
- Any institution not eligible had to provide assurance by June 15, 2021
- Requirement to report use of funds

The State agency will begin disbursing funds to institutions upon receipt

TBD in July 2021

July 31, 2021

The State agency will request additional funds from FNS (if applicable)

Funds obligation deadline

Sept 30, 2021

Jan 31, 2022

Funds liquidation deadline  
Recovery process begins  
Institutions must report to the State agency of the use of funds

*All institutions receiving Emergency Cost Reimbursement must report back to the State agency how the funds were used. The State agency must submit a summary the use of funds to FNS by March 31, 2022*

(3) This memorandum applies to administering State agencies and institutions operating the Child and Adult Care Food Program in emergency shelters.


