P-EBT for Child Care

Child and Adult Care Food Program

- P-EBT for Children Under Six was issued through the end of May.
- Summer P-EBT is now in effect
 - Each child is eligible for one-P-EBT benefit during the summer months
 - Amount of \$375 per child will be paid in one payment to families currently participating in Food and Nutrition Services (SNAP)
 - Payments are scheduled to go out later this month








Emergency Operating Cost Grants Child and Adult Care Food Program

All institutions receiving Emergency Cost Reimbursement must report back to the State agency how the funds were used. The State agency must submit a summary the use of funds to FNS by March 31, 2022

(2) This memorandum relates to requirements at 42 U.S.C. 1766(r) and 42 U.S.C. 1766(t) to allow emergency shelters to claim reimbursement for meals and snacks served to individuals under the age of 25. (3) This memorandum applies to administering State agencies and institutions operating the Child and Adult Care Food Program in emergency shelters.

Please complete the waiver request form below to request one or more waivers below for your institution. Each waiver request form must be approved by the State agency prior to the institution implementing any or all the flexibilities listed below.

The following list of nationwide waivers provided to the NC CACFP are extensions of the USDA Child Nutrition program waivers in response to the Families First Coronavirus Response Act.

Update for School Year 2021-2022

- Non-Congregate Meal Service
- Meal Times Requirements
- · Specific Meal Pattern Flexibility (there are only three flexibilities allowed, read carefully)
- Allow Parents and Guardians to Pick Meals for Children
- Area Eligibility in the At-Risk Afterschool Meal (ARAM) Programs and for Family Day Care Home
 Providers
- Onsite Monitoring Requirements for Sponsoring Organizations

Institutions MUST apply and be approved for each waiver they would like to use.

PLEASE NOTE: IF APPROVED, THESE WAIVERS ARE EFFECTIVE BEGINNING JULY 1, 2021.

 - Conflict of Interest Acknowledgement and Policy-all institutions
- 3. SAM Registration (Required for ALL Institutions)


