Goal: To prevent early childhood tooth decay in North Carolina by educating and informing audiences about early childhood oral health issues and best practices.

Rationale: Baby teeth are important! Hear the latest on early childhood oral health – everything from national statistics to policies of the American Academy of Pediatrics and American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry. If you work with young children or their parents, you'll want to know this valuable information and how you can help prevent tooth decay.

Target audience: Adults influencing the oral health of young children and their parents: child care providers, WIC staff, other community partners.
