Tier Two: Student Directed Activities with Seizure Diagnosis

- Follow <u>School Nurse Case Management Process Model</u>
 - 1. Case find using physician orders, staff referrals, attendance records, school information forms, and student assessment
 - 2. Assess/Gather Information using subjective and objective data
 - 3. Nursing Judgment on Level of Student Need Does the student need case management services based on findings?
 - a. Develop and Implement appropriate Emergency Action Plan, Medication Orders, and serve through general school health services if case management not indicated.

Tier Three: Intensive Student Directed Activities with New or Uncontrolled Seizure Diagnosis

- Continue with <u>School Nurse Case Management Process Model</u>
 - 1. Plan of Care
 - a. NASN Clinical Guidelines Clinical Guideline for Students with Seizures and Epilepsy
 - b. North Carolina Plan of Care Template NC Plan of Care/Individualized Healthcare Plan Template
 - c. NASN Use of Individualized Healthcare Plans to Support School Health Services
 - 2. Implement plan
 - 3. Evaluate and revise or return student to general School Health Services (Tier Two)
