<p>The Program Narrative clearly describes all aspects of how the implementation of PORS will be carried out and how it fits into and enhances the system of care for individuals in the target group outcomes. The narrative</p>	

<p>clearly describes the timeline, target group of individuals, the geographical area, how the LME/MCO and providers with identify consumers for PORS, and the data collections process and how the intended outcomes will be met in measurable terms. There is a plan to educate, engage and collaborate with other providers and community stakeholders.</p>
