





# **Seriously Deficient**

- SD Notices will be sent to the 67 Institutions that have started but Not submitted their Record the week of April 1, 2024.







## New Fields in the Facility Dashboard

# Overview of Proposed Changes to the Serious Deficiency Process

- Established a serious deficiency process in SFSP
- Extends the serious deficiency process to CACFP unaffiliated sponsored centers
- Redefines findings that trigger the SD process as "serious management problems"
- Changes the point at which program operators are declared seriously deficient




