## **Record Renewal Training is Required**

If training is not completed Institutions will:

- be submitted as Seriously Deficient after approval deadline (February 29, 2024)
- not have access to FY 2024 in NC CACFP CONNECTS (starting September 25, 2023)
- not be able to file claims until approval

# Policy Memos

### CACFP 09-2023

- Funding allocated to further develop technology used in the CACFP
- May be applied toward system planning, implementation, and/or maintenance, as well as enhancements for State agency operations

- Child Nutrition Program Integrity Final Rule
- Modernizes oversight of child nutrition programs
- Streamlines oversight requirements
  - Lowers administrative burden
  - $_{\odot}$  Tailored to each organization based on needs
- More detail to follow over next few slides

- Flexibilities allowed in frequency of reviews for school food authorities
  - Based on good performance reviews over time
- Organizations at risk of serious management issues will receive more frequent oversight
- Effective Date when the rule becomes active
- Compliance Date when the provision must be followed

- What's New?
  - Adds additional criteria for State agency to use when scheduling reviews
  - Requires state agencies to provide fair and timely hearings
  - Adds a provision to require SA's to conduct a more in-depth financial review of SO's
  - Requires SO's to enter into permanent agreements with their unaffiliated centers

- What has already been implemented through guidance?
  - $\,\circ\,$  Increased amount of audit funds
  - Initial app for new institutions; annual updates for renewing institutions
  - Varied timing of SO reviews and type of meal service reviewed
  - Tier II DCH assistance in collecting and transmitting applications to SO's
  - Simplified calculation of monthly admin reimbursement for SO's of DCH
  - $\,\circ\,$  Carryover of SO's of DCH administrative funds

#### **Fines for Violating Program Requirements**

 Allows the State agency to impose a fine against an SFA and Allows FNS to impose a fine against a State agency under exceptional circumstances only.

#### **Food Service Management Companies**

- Requires each State agency to annually review and approve each contract and contract amendment between any SFA and FSMC in the **NSLP**
- Defines fixed-price contract in the School Meal Programs.
- Requires that the value of USDA foods accrue only to the benefits of the SFA's nonprofit school food service account

#### **State Agency Review Requirements in CACFP**

• Establishes additional priorities and criteria for State agencies to use in selecting institutions for review

#### State Liability for Payments to Aggrieved Child Care Institutions

• Requires State agencies to provide fair and timely hearings through the serious deficiency process.

#### **Financial Review of Sponsoring Organizations**

- Requires the State agency have procedures in place to annually review sponsoring organization's bank activity.
- Requires the State agency have procedures in place to annually review a sponsoring organization's actual expenditures.

# Standard Agreements Between Sponsoring Organizations and Sponsored Child Care Centers

- Requires sponsoring organization to enter into permanent agreements with their unaffiliated centers.
- Adds a new definition of facility and sponsored center.



#### **CACFP Audit Funds**

 Allows FNS to increase the amount of audit funds if a State agency demonstrates that it can effectively use the funds to improve program management.

#### **Elimination of the Annual Application for Institutions**

• Requires an initial application for new institutions and annual updates, as needed, re renewing institutions.

  - -FY2024-All institutions will "Level Set"
    - Permanent Agreement
      - Attachments A-I
    - Additional Documentation
      - CACFP Fact Sheet
      - Statement of Authority
      - Non-profit status

#### **Timing of Unannounced Reviews**

 Requires sponsoring organizations to vary the timing of unannounced reviews and vary the type of meal service subject to review.

#### **Collection and Transmission of Household Income** Information

• Adds the right of the tier II day care home to assist in collecting and transmitting applications to sponsoring organizations

#### Calculation of Administrative Funding for Sponsoring Organizations of Day Care Homes

• Simplifies the calculation of monthly administrative reimbursement that sponsoring organizations of day care homes are eligible to receive.

#### Carryover of Administrative Funding for Sponsoring Organizations of Day Care Homes

- Allows carryover of administrative funds with State agency approval.
- Requires the State agency to establish procedures to recover administrative funds from sponsoring organizations of day care homes.

#### **NCAS to NCFS**

• October 1, 2023, the North Carolina Office of State Controller (OSC) will replace the North Carolina Accounting System (NCAS) with the North Carolina Financial System (NCFS).

NCAS	NCFS
Federal Identification Number	Data Elements from Substitute W-9

- Guidance will be forthcoming
- What institutions must do in order to plan for the switch:
  - Complete Substitute W-9 (once the State Agency has clarification on the form)
  - Go on the IRS.gov website to ensure you have the correct name of your Institution as it is listed on the IRS website
    - All forms that do not match the IRS website will be rejected
    - If forms are rejected, institutions will not be able to file a claim for reimbursement until corrected
