Healthy Families America	Mark Ownbey Mark.ownbey@dhhs.nc.gov	• Eligibility occurs either prenatally or within 3 months after the birth of the baby and continues until children are 3 to 5 years old • Offers hour-long home visits at least weekly until children are 6 months old, with the possibility of less frequent visits thereafter
Nurse-Family Partnership	Amanda Leigh Amanda.leigh@dhhs.nc.gov	• First-time mothers enrolled before 28 weeks gestation • Family must meet low-income criteria • Families enrolled until the child turns 2 • High-risk (teen pregnancy, unemployment, maternal health risks, poverty, unstable housing, limited support, etc.)
