Featured Presentation: Strengthening North Carolina's Direct Care Workforce

In the 2024 report, Investing in North Carolina's Caregiving Workforce, NC DHHS and the NC Department of Commerce observed that "North Carolina lacks reliable and actionable data surrounding its direct care workforce."
