How will families receive their benefits?			
Active FNS Households with P-EBT eligible children:	These benefits will be issued to the existing EBT card; however, it should be noted that some P-EBT eligible children were not successfully matched with their existing FNS case. Therefore, some households may receive benefits on an existing EBT card AND receive a separate P-EBT card for other children in the household that had an unsuccessful match.		
Non-FNS Households with P-EBT eligible children:	Families who fall into this category will receive a letter from DHHS in the mail explaining how to activate and use their card. These benefits will be issued on a white, P-EBT card and mailed in the next few weeks. Please note, that while every effort was made to group siblings into one household, there are instances where this was unsuccessful, and more than one card has been issued for the home.
