RECREATIONAL THERAPY INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Broughton Hospital strives to offer a variety of excellent clinical education experiences for Recreational Therapy students. Internships are available to Associate, Bachelors and Masters level students. All clinical supervisors are licensed by the North Carolina Board of Recreational Therapy Licensure and certified by the National Council of Recreational Therapy certification (where applicable).

Internship experiences may be available in Adult Admission Services, Geriatrics Services, Deaf Services, Youth Services and Adult Extended Treatment Services. Internships at Broughton Hospital are unpaid, however low-cost housing is available on campus. The Broughton Hospital internship experience is 15 weeks in duration with 1 week of hospital orientation and 14 weeks of clinical Recreational Therapy training. Internships are available in Spring semester (beginning January 1) or Fall Semester (beginning August 1).
