Purpose of this Notice: The purpose of this notice is to provide public notification of DCDEE's intent to release a Request for Applications.

Program Name: Specialized Birth-3 Technical Assistance Program

Purpose of the RFA: The purpose of this RFA is to establish statewide Birth to Age 3 coaching and mentoring services. The primary focus will be to increase the availability of high-quality infant and toddler care for families across North Carolina through the provision of individualized coaching, mentoring, and specialized consultation to providers in licensed family child care homes, child care centers, and religious sponsored child care programs, regardless of their star rating. The function of this system is to coordinate the work of technical assistance practitioners that specialize in infant and toddler development and culturally inclusive best practices for children birth to three years of age.

Description: The successful applicant must establish a statewide program plan providing services in all 100 counties of North Carolina differentiating service deliver to meet the unique needs of child care programs and their workforce.

Funding Availability: This RFA will for a 2-year funding cycle with an optional 1-year renewal term. One award of up to \$2,550,000 per year will be made under this RFA to provide services set forth in the Scope of Services. Eligibility for the renewal is contingent upon contract compliance, project performance, and availability of funding. The initial contract period is expected to be February 1, 2026 – January 31, 2028.

DCEE will determine the actual funding amount based on the proposed execution of the project and the utilization of funds as outlined in the successful applicant's proposal, pending funding availability.

Applicant Eligibility: This RFA is open to state agencies and universities, public and private nonprofit organizations with a current 501(c)(3) standing with knowledge of North's Carolina's early childhood education mixed delivery system and expertise in developmentally appropriate practices for young children birth – 12 years of age.
