These realignments (if necessary) will occur in January 2022 and May 2022 based on received requests for additional funding resources and confirmed availability of funding from counties that are not utilizing all of their programmatic funds. Funding realignments reducing funding will be non-recurring unless the same program reduced funds in SFY2020-2021. If prior year program funding was reduced, the amount of the recurring reduction will be the lesser amount of the two fiscal periods.
