## Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities & Substance Use Services UPDATE

## Sunsetting of Flexibilities in the Provision of State-Funded IDD and TBI Services During the Aftermath of Hurricane Helene

The Division of MH/DD/SUS, in partnership with the DHHS Division of Health Benefits (DHB) NC Medicaid and the Division of Health Service Regulation (DHSR), temporarily modified some of its Mental Health, Substance Use Disorder, Intellectual and Developmental Disability and Traumatic Brain Injury clinical policies to better enable the delivery of care to individuals impacted by Hurricane Helene. The impacted mental health and substance use services were sunset on February 28, 2025. See the <u>December 12, 2024 Communication Bulletin</u> for more details.

The remaining flexibilities, which pertain to IDD and TBI services, will end June 30, 2025. Providers should return to normal business operations effective June 30, 2025, to be compliant with the Division of MH/DD/SUS' state-funded service definitions. Below is a list of the service flexibilities that are sunsetting on June 30, 2025:
