BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

The United States WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by **8 percent** between 2010 and 2022.

2010	65%
2022	70%

Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in the United States in 2022, **23 percent** continued breastfeeding at 6 months.



Fruit and Vegetable Benefit: Congress enhanced WIC's fruit and vegetable benefit to align with scientific recommendations. Current monthly benefit amounts are \$26 for children, \$47 for pregnant and postpartum participants, and \$52 for breastfeeding participants. In FY 2023, WIC provided an estimated **\$1.9B** in fruit and vegetable benefits to **5.1M** participants in the United States.
